ORDINANCE No. 1026

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING ORDINANCE #402 AND REPEALING ORDINANCE #401 AND 401A IN REGARDS TO NUISANCES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF THE CITY OF HERNDON, RAWLINS COUNTY, KS

AN ORDINANCE EMPOWERING THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF HERNDON, KANSAS TO CAUSE TO HAVE REMOVED OR ABATED FROM ANY LOT OR PARCEL ANY OR ALL NUISANCES WITHIN SAID CITY, PRESCRIBING A PROCEDURE FOR THE COMPLETION OF SUCH ABATEMENT OR REMOVAL, PROVIDING FOR A PUBLIC HEARING THEREON AND FOR A NOTICE THEREOF, PROVIDING FOR THE IMMEDIATE REMOVAL WITHOUT PRIOR NOTICE OR HEARING OF STRUCTURES WHICH CONSTITUTE IMMEDIATE HAZARD.

SECTION 1. PURPOSE. The governing body has found that there are nuisances which may pose a menace or constitutes a blighting influence upon the area in which it is located thereby causing a loss in property value to surrounding property or dangerous to the health of the inhabitants of the city.

SECTION 2. DEFINITIONS. For the purpose of this ordinance, the following words and terms shall have the following meanings:

- PUBLIC OFFICER means the City Council of HERNDON, Kansas or its authorized representative.
- NUISANCE is defined as trash, debris, or refuse including but not by way of limitation, appliances, building material, discarded furniture, cans, barrels, paper, rags, cartons, boxes, glass, broken crockery, limbs, pieces of wood or metal, livestock feed such as hay or bagged grain and other discarded materials of every kind and character.

SECTION 3. PUBLIC OFFICER DUTIES: The public officer is hereby authorized to exercise such power as may be necessary to carry out the purposes of this ordinance, including the following:

- Inspect any lot or tract which appears to have nuisances on it.
- Report all nuisances which he or she believes to be detrimental to the public health or in violation of this ordinance.
- Receive reports as provided in this ordinance.

SECTION 4. PROCEDURE. Action may be initiated in either of the following manners:

- Whenever an informal complaint is made to the Governing Body of said City or it otherwise has notice of the existence of an apparent violation of this ordinance, it may cause a notice in writing to be served upon the person in possession or the owner of real property upon which such nuisance is located. Such notice shall inform such person of the violation and direct that he or she notify the city within 10 days of their intentions or produce a plan of action after receipt of such notice to comply with the provisions of this ordinance. He or she will be given 30 days to comply with the provisions of this ordinance. In the event such person fails to comply with the provisions of this ordinance within such time he or she shall be subject to fines for the violation of this ordinance.

SECTION 5. PENALTY. Any person in violation of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon notice thereof, be fined in an amount not to exceed one hundred dollars (\$100.00). Each day during or on which a violation occurs or continues shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION 6. AUTHORITY. This ordinance is adopted of and under the provisions of K.S.A. 12-1617 through 12-1617 (g).

SECTION 7. REPEAL. Ordinance #401, 401A and 402 of the City of Herndon, Kansas is hereby repealed.

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after its publication in the Rawlins County Square Deal, the Official City Newspaper.

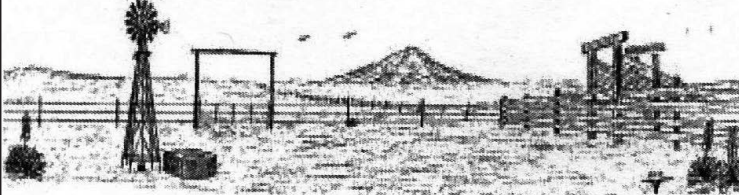

Resolution 2025-05 Amending Resolution No. 2025-03

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING LANDFILL FEES FOR THE RAWLINS COUNTY LANDFILL, RAWLINS COUNTY, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners of Rawlins County, Kansas, Pursuant to K.S.A. 65-3410 desires to establish Landfill fees at the Rawlins County Landfill for the disposal of construction/demolition materials, tires, hazardous materials, chemicals, and appliances with freon.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF RAWLINS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS IN RAWLINS COUNTY, KANSAS that the following fees will be charged at the Rawlins County Landfill:

Construction/Demolition/Shingles/Wood/Insulation:

Semi-Trailer: \$300.00

Tandem Axle Truck: \$150.00

Single Axle Truck: \$75.00

Tandem Axle Trailer: \$75.00

Pick-up Truck: \$30.00

Additional \$50.00 Charge for Any Hazardous Materials On Any Truck or Trailer

Single Door: \$10.00

Single Window: \$10.00

Tire Rates:

17" or Less: \$5.00

17.1" to 20": \$6.00

Semi-Truck: \$12.00

Super Single/Dual/Pivot Irrigation: \$23.00

Tractor 18.4" or Less: \$155.00

Tractor Larger than 18.4": \$250.00

Hazardous Materials and Chemicals:

Flat Charge: \$100.00

Required: Lids Need to Be Off and Triple Rinsed

Appliances with Freon: \$10.00

No Charge for Tree Trimmings and Grass

Businesses will be billed monthly for charges accumulated during that month. Any outstanding bills will be added to the business's tax statements as a special assessment.

Residents/Individuals will be required to pay fees to Landfill personnel prior to dumping for the following items only: tires, appliances with freon, hazardous materials, and chemicals. Residents of Rawlins County will not be charged a tipping fee at the Rawlins County Landfill for household waste.

All fees set forth in this Resolution apply to everyone utilizing the Rawlins County Landfill. The Rawlins County Board of County Commissioners reserve the right to exempt specific organizations or specific projects, from this Resolution, upon a majority vote.

This Resolution shall take effect on June 1, 2025, upon its passage and its publication in the County Official newspaper for two continuous publications.
