

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PARKING AND OPERATION OF VEHICLES UPON STREETS DURING WINTER STORM TRAFFIC EMERGENCIES AND UPON STREETS DESIGNATED AS EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, THAT THE OPERATION OF VEHICLES ON STREETS COVERED BY HEAVY ACCUMULATION OF SNOW AND THE PARKING OF VEHICLES ON EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES ARE MATTERS AFFECTING THE HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE OF THE CITIZENS OF THE CITY FOR THE REASON THAT PARKED, STALLED AND ABANDONED VEHICLES IMPEDE SNOW SERIOUS CLEARING/REMOVAL OPERATIONS AND CAUSES CONGESTION.

THEREFORE, THE GOVERNING BODY PASS THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE, TO-WIT:

- DECLARATION OF WINTER STORM TRAFFIC EMERGENCY. The Mayor or designee may declare a winter storm traffic emergency whenever snow has accumulated or there is a possibility that snow will accumulate to such a depth that snow clearing/removal operations will be required, or weather conditions otherwise warrant the declaration of a winter storm traffic emergency for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the city, in the opinion of the Mayor. The Mayor will then implement the following phases depending upon the severity of the winter storm traffic emergency and until such winter storm traffic emergency is terminated, it shall be unlawful to do the following during each phase:
  - Phase 1. To park a vehicle on any street designated as an emergency snow route in subsection (D) of this section.
  - To operate any vehicle upon any city Phase II. street except those vehicles designated by the Mayor as snow clearing/removal or emergency vehicles.
- NOTICE OF WINTER STORM TRAFFIC EMERGENCY; TERMINATION. Upon declaring a winter storm traffic emergency, the Mayor or designee shall promptly cause appropriate notice to be given to the local press, radio and other media on the severity of the emergency and the phase upon which the The winter storm traffic emergency Mayor has invoked. shall be terminated by notice substantially in the same manner as it was declared.
