Hiawatha Post 66 Splits With Corning Legion

Hiawatha Post 66 beat the Corning Legion 13-9, in the first game on Sunday.

Aden Grathwohl started on the mound first for Hiawatha Post 66. Grathwohl allowed six hits and eight runs (Five earned) over five innings, striking out four and walking five. Cooper Wischropp appeared in relief for Hiawatha Post 66.

Hiawatha Post 66 got on the board in the top of the first inning after Grathwohl grounded out, and Tagen Diller singled down the left field line, each scoring one run.

Hiawatha Post 66 extended their early lead with six runs in the top of the second thanks to home runs by Gannon Becker and Grathwohl.

Hiawatha Post 66 added to their early lead in the top of the third inning after Corning Legion committed an error, Lucas Lancaster grounded out, and Grathwohl singled to left field. Each scored one run.

Corning Legion scored four runs in the bottom of the third on a grand slam to center field by Corning player Hunter Lamond on a full count.

Micah Oldham hit a solo home run to center field in the top of the fourth for the Hiawatha Post 66.

Hiawatha Post 66 scored one run in the top of the seventh on a solo home run to left field by Dalton Siebenmorgan.

Hiawatha Post 66 had a great game at the plate. The offense was led by Grathwohl. He hit a home run to center field in the second inning, scoring three runs and singled in the third inning, scoring one. Hiawatha Post 66 totaled 15 hits in the game. Tagen Diller went three-for-four at the plate to lead Hiawatha Post 66 in hits. Dalton Siebenmorgan, Gannon Becker, Micah Oldham, and Rhen Hageman each collected multiple hits for Hiawatha Post 66. Hiawatha Post 66 showed great patience at the plate, tallying seven walks for the game. Lucas Lancaster and Cooper Jacobsen led the team with two free passes each.
