April 30 is deadline for Boys State applications

Less than a month remains to apply for the 2025 session of the American Legion Boys State of Kansas, to be held Sunday, June 1, through Saturday, June 7, at Kansas State University in Manhattan. The deadline is set for Wednesday, April 30. Applications are accepted after that date, but on a spaceavailable basis. This will be the 87th session of the Kansas Boys State program and the 33rd consecutive year at KSU.

Traditionally, Kansas Boys State has been for individuals who will complete their junior year of high school in the spring just prior to the start of each session. However, the ALBSK programma again expanded the pott of pplicants for this year's session to also include those who will complete their sophomore year of high school this spring. There is no limit on the number of delegates a sch ommunity or post can send Ameri to atter Boys State. Th an Legion Boys Sta as program provides interactive, problemexperience d teamwork in leade that de self-identity, promotes ial respect and

instills civic responsibility to inculcate a sense of individual obligation to community, state and nation. Boys State is a "learning by doing" political exercise that simulates elections, political parties and government at the state, county and local levels, providing opportunities to lead under pressure, showcasing character and working effectively within a team. It's also an opportunity to gain pride and respect for government, and the price paid by members of the military to preserve democracy.

The cost to attend the Boys State of Kansas program is \$375; however, in many instances, sponsors pay the majority of the fees, with the delegate or his family paying \$50. Those wishing to attend the 2025 session should visit ksbstate.org to apply.

State Kansas Boys attendees are eligible to receive a three-hour course credit (Introduction to Political Science [POLSC 110]) through Kansas State University, as well as earn merit badges to attain the Eagle Scout rank through Boy Scouts
