


True bugs belong to the order Hemiptera and include a wide range of insects like aphids, cica-

das, stink bugs and water striders. Examples of 'other bugs' or non-Hemipteran insects are beetles, flies, ants, bees, wasps, butterflies, and moths.

mate and lay eggs.

Some years, their populations can grow rather large. Despite their sometimesalarming abundance, they generally are not a problem for ornamental plants. They do like to feed on pepper and spinach seedlings and are attracted to a many of the spring weedy flowering plants like henbit, which is abundant this time of year.

As with all insect pests, it is important to investigate and weigh the loss of plants or fruits and vegetables versus the impact on beneficial insects before applying pesticides. If you have a bug that you need identified call the extension office at 620-
