Kansas Farm And Ranch Numbers RemainUnchanged

MANHATTAN, KS. — Kansas's number of farms and ranches remained unchanged during 2024, according to USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. The number of farms and ranches in the state, at 55,500, was unchanged from 2023. Numbers of farms and ranches in Kansas with less than \$100,000 in agricultural sales decreased 500 farms from a year earlier while operations with agricultural sales of \$100,000 or more increased 500 farms.

Land in farms and ranches in Kansas totaled 44.8 million acres, unchanged from 2023. The average size of operation, at 807 acres, was unchanged acres from a year earlier.
