

Mayor Angie Alexander called the meeting to order at 5:02pm. Council President Matt Gardner and Councilmembers Taner Hayes and Tammy Mc-Daniel were in attendance but Councilmen Bucky Smith and Paul Calvert were unable to attend. City Clerk Lori Ryan and Chief of Police Chuck Berry were in attendance as well. Hayes motioned to approve the Consent Agenda with 3/21/25 Payroll Appropriations Ordinance #7366 for \$11,910.93 and McDaniel seconded. Expenditure Appropriation Ordinance #7345 in the amount of \$93,377.08 was motioned for approval by Gardner and seconded by McDaniel.

Appearances – Steve Clark sat-in on the Meeting. City Superintendent Jay Spengler Report – Public Works Team completed regular routine chores such as Running wells, Emptied trash on Main, completed One-Call Locates, Pushed-

up the Burn Site north of town, Monthly Water Meter Reading for Utility Bills. Superintendent Spengler said he and his three men did a few Service Orders for water turn-ons. Fixed leaking hydraulic hose on small bucket truck. Trimmed trees south of town that were too close to lines and causing problems. Took down Happy New Year banners and rehung Attica banners. Replaced baby swing at Mc-Caddon Park. Fixed water leak on N Harper. Removed old pole and streetlight that was no longer used along highway. Repaired broken electrical wire at CoOp. 
during wind storm. Talked with a guy about a small cell
