Moments in time

• On Feb. 23, 1885, John Lee went to the gallows in Exeter, England, for allegedly murdering Emma Keyse, a rich older woman who'd employed him. Insisting he was innocent, he was nonetheless convicted and sentenced to hang. However, the lever to release the floor beneath his feet malfunctioned and he didn't drop. Baffled authorities sent him back to prison for the next 22 years, though his death sentence was commuted. Upon his release, he emigrated to America, leaving the cause of his reprieve unsolved.

• On Feb. 24, 1961, the first 15 students received their Bachelor of Hamburgerology degree (not a traditional academic one!) from McDonald's Hamburger University, aka the "Harvard of Fast Food."

• On Feb. 25, 1837, Vermont blacksmith Thomas Davenport received the first U.S. patent for an electric motor. He insulated the wires with strips of fabric from his wife's silk wedding dress (cut by his wife, and with her full approval).

Notice Concerning Proposed Kansas
Air Quality Class I Operating Permit

Notice is hereby given that the Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE) is soliciting comments regarding a proposed air quality operating permit. **Tallgrass Interstate Gas Transmission, LLC – Tescott Station** has applied for a Class I operating permit in accordance with the provisions of K.A.R. 28-19-510 et al. The purpose of a Class I permit is to identify the sources and types of regulated air pollutants emitted from the facility; the emission limitations, standards and requirements applicable to each source; and the monitoring, recordkeeping and reporting requirements applicable to each source as of the effective date of permit issuance.

Tallgrass Interstate Gas Transmission, LLC – Tescott Station, 370 Van Gordon St, Lakewood, Colorado, 80228, owns and operates a natural gas transmission facility located at **587 North 30th Rd, Tescott, Ottawa County, Kansas, 67484**.

A copy of the proposed permit, permit application, all supporting documentation, and all information relied upon during the permit application review process are available for public review, during normal business hours, at the KDHE, Bureau of Air (BOA), 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366 and at the **KDHE North Central District Office, 3040 Enterprise Dr, Salina Kansas, 67401**. To obtain or review the proposed permit and supporting documentation, contact **Angela Bryson** at **785-296-3589** at the central office of KDHE or **Jessica Fair** at **785-827-9639**, at the **KDHE North Central District Office**. The standard departmental cost will be assessed for any copies requested. The proposed permit, accompanied with supporting information, is available, free of charge, at the KDHE BOA Public Notice website, <https://www.kdhe.ks.gov/413/Public-Notices>.

Please direct written comments or questions regarding the proposed permit to **Angela Bryson**, KDHE, BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366. In order to be considered in formulating a final permit decision, written comments must be received no later than noon on **Monday, March 23, 2026**.

A person may request a public hearing be held on the proposed permit. The request for a public hearing shall be in writing and set forth the basis for the request. The written request must be submitted to **Angela Bryson**, KDHE, BOA, 1000 SW Jackson, Suite 310, Topeka, KS 66612-1366, no later than noon on **Monday, March 23, 2026**, in order for the Secretary of Health and Environment to consider the request.

The United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has a 45-day review period, which will start concurrently with public comment period, within which to object to the proposed permit. If the USEPA has not objected in writing to the issuance of the permit within the 45-day review period, any person may petition the administrator of the USEPA to review the permit. The 60-day public petition period will directly follow the USEPA 45-day review period.

Any such petition shall be based only on objections to the permit that were raised with reasonable specificity during the public comment period provided for in this notice, unless the petitioner demonstrates that it was impracticable to raise such objections within such period, or unless the grounds for such objection arose after such period.
