CITY OF ALLEN, KANSAS
ORDINANCE NO. 199

AN ORDINANCE PERTAINING TO THE WATER RATES FOR USERS OF WATER FROM THE CITY OF ALLEN KANSAS WATERWORKS SYSTEM.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ALLEN, KANSAS:
SECTION 1. That the rate for water to consumers shall be as follows: The first 1,000 gallons for \$19.35; each additional 1,000 gallons at \$9.35 per 1,000 gallons. The minimum rate shall be \$19.35 per current month. All billings will be to the nearest thousand gallon.
SECTION 2. That all ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.
SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force after its publication in the Emporia Gazette.
Passed by the governing body and approved by the Mayor of the City of Allen, Kansas, on this 7th day of April, 2025.
