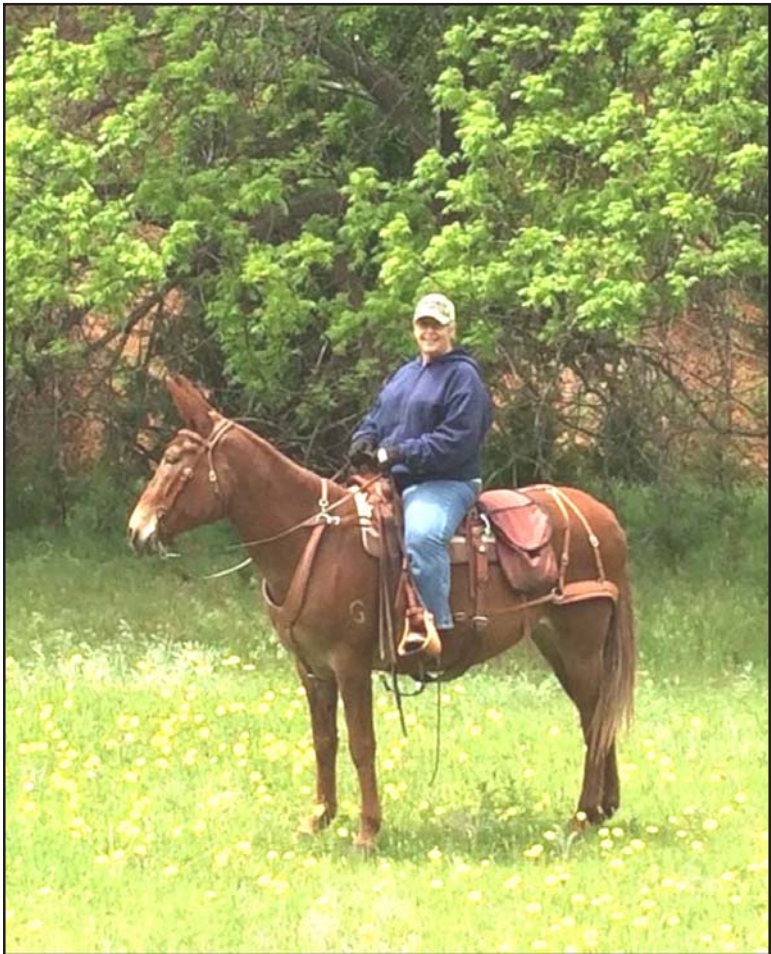
people.
