(23%) expressed support for ending mail-in voting options.

Even fewer (11.6%) think voter fraud is a routine problem in Kansas.

The move to curtail mail-in voting in Kansas is not just a policy change—it's a philosophical one.

It signals a departure from a long-standing tradition of making voting easier for those who cannot be physically present at the polls. From Civil War soldiers to modern-day students and retirees, mail-in voting has served as a vital tool for civic participation.

As the 2026 midterms approach and calls to eliminate mail-in ballots echo from the nation's capi-

tol, Kansans—both voters and lawmakers alike—face a pivotal choice: whether to uphold a long-standing democratic tradition or allow it to be quietly dismantled.

The debate is not merely about deadlines and delivery speeds, it's about the kind of democracy Kansans want to preserve. Will it be one that adapts to the needs of its citizens, or one that narrows the path to the ballot box?

In the end, the question isn't whether mail-in voting is convenient. It's whether it's essential.

History suggests it is.
