Notice of Explanation

The City of Lenora, Kansas, has received Community Development Block Grant funds for water system improvements. The scope of work includes the abandonment of all cast iron water lines, lead goosenecks and lead joints in the water distribution system. New water lines will be constructed with the installation of 4” and 6” plastic polyvinyl chloride (PVC) pipe and will include tracer wire. Connections to the existing 4” water line are planned plus one connection to an existing 8” waterline. The project includes mobilization, gate valves, installation of two-way fire hydrants, reconnections of existing fire hydrant, plus service line connections, water meter replacement, 2 river crossings, service line and street repairs. Because several locations of water lines are identified to be in the floodplain, working in the floodplain cannot be avoided. As part of the concept development of this project, the proposed improvements were placed to minimize the floodplain impacts. The location of the proposed improvements in the floodplain will be constructed utilizing directional boring to minimize impact to the floodplain/wetland. Directional boring of proposed river crossings will eliminate the need for fill to be placed in the floodplain. The project engineer does not envision the need for a floodplain fill permit from the Kansas Department of Water Resources. Based on the existing distribution system as well as the fact that regionalization is not an option, there are no feasible alternative actions which will fulfill an identical project objective. The proposed project’s adverse impacts on the floodplain are believed to be minimal, meaning that correlation between the proposed project and any threats to lives and property is relatively low. Since directional boring under the river is proposed, the negative impacts to additional flooding on adjacent properties is minimal if it exists at all. There will be no impact to the designated wetland areas due to directionally boring the river crossings. Upon the completion of construction all disturbed areas will be seeded and erosion control measures will be added to minimize erosion of the site for a future 100-year storm event. Short term impacts to the wetland area are negligible and would be isolated to bore pit locations during construction of the river crossings. Bore pit sites will be restored to preconstruction conditions. The long-term impact of the floodplain/wetland for this are due to the construction of the proposed project is minimal. Impact, if any, caused by construction of the projects is also negligible. This is a significant water infrastructure improvement for the community. It also creates little to no negative impacts to the floodplain or the surrounding property. There are no other feasible alternatives that meet the goals and objectives of the project and avoids the floodplain.
