on hand to help the younger workers during that day's pumpkin harvest.

"Livestock is my main job but I help with the vegetables as needed, whatever requires the manpower," said Turner.

Asked why he's chosen farm work over a desk job, Turner had ready answers.

"I grew up on a cattle ranch in South Alabama, actually," said Turner, who now resides in Leavenworth. "I like working seven minutes from home and doing stuff that makes sense and where I also have time with my family. For me, it's just what I grew up doing and it makes sense to me. This may be a smaller operation compared to other farms, but this is something that is important. It's what my family would call God's work – stuff that

needs to be done, whether on this level or on a bigger one. We need the vegetables, we need the beef, the chickens, we need the eggs. Whether people come to us or not, what we're doing is what people rely on every day. It feels more purposeful here than any of the other jobs I've had."

Harvested pumpkins, gourds and colorful mums – along with a fully stocked farm store of products – are available at the JET Produce and Meats farm store,


