The project involves an asphalt overlay consisting of a 1" leveling course and a 1.5" surface course on a segment of RS 359 (NW 170th) about 2 miles long beginning at the north edge of pavement of 1st St. and extending approx. 2 miles north to the south edge of pavement of NW 20th St. Exceptions for the overlay include the bridge located about 1.4 miles north of 1st St. The project is based on 21.0' to 22.0' wide surfaces, and new 1.5' to 2.5' AB-3 shoulder widening.
