CJHS records fall, season ends at CCCJ League Meet

Three new Titan records replaced the old during the CCCJ League Track and Field Meet, April 29 in Girard. Though it was a cold, wet day, Blaze Bowman, Sammi Ohmart, and Jayden Dohle set new marks for the Columbus Junior High School Track and Field Teams with seventh schools competing in 15 events.

Jayden added his third mark to the record book this season with an improved time for the eighth grade 100 Meter Dash. His time of 11.6 seconds beat the previous mark held by Nate Bole of 11.71 seconds. Jayden also set the 400 Meter Dash record and is a member of the record setting 4x800 Meter Relay Team with new marks April 17 at the Girard Invitational

Dohle also holds the seventh grade 400 Meter Dash record. Blaze added his name

to a second record by breaking the 2013, 100 Meter Hurdle record set by Keenan Stanley. Bowman's time of 16.4 seconds edged Stanley's 16.65 second mark. The seventh grade

4x800 Meter Relay Team of which Blaze is a member also set a new record in the Girard Invitational meet, April 17. Lady Titan Seventh

Grader, Sammi Ohmart, added her name beside her sister, Montana's, when she broke the 800 Meter Run record with a time of 2:42.9 minutes. The new mark beat the 2003 time of 2:44.1 minutes set by Chelsey Humble.

Montana Ohmart holds the 1600 Meter Run record, directly below the 800 Meter entry in the records The eighth grade boys

finished third in the team scoring at the league meet with Dohle sweeping the dashes earning first place medals in the 100 Meter, 200 Meter, and 400 Meter Dashes. His fourth medal is silver, placing second with the 4x100 Meter Relay Team of Alex Montierth, Cooper Reid, and Kannon

Jace Gaither, the current school record holder, paced the eighth grade field events taking first place in the Shot Put and Discus

St. Mary's-Colgan won the eighth grade boys division with 147 team points. Girard got past Columbus with 78 team points for second place and the Titans finished with 75.

The eighth grade Lady Titans placed fourth in team standings with 47 points led by a Graci Zook who placed first in the High Jump and Mollie Sauerwein who placed second in the Pole Vault

Girard won the eighth grade girls division with 140 team points, St. Mary's-Colgan was second with 107 points, and Frontenac placed third with 91 team points. In addition to Bow-

man's first place, record setting mark in the seventh grade, boys hurdles, he took first place in the long jump and joined Cord Saporito, Hayden Kellogg, and Elijah Shoemaker to take second in the 4x400 Meter Relay. Shoemaker

added points to the team total with a first place medal in the 400 Meter Dash. Tanner Scott was sec-

ond in the Pole Vault to help put the Titans in fourth place in team standings with 66 total points. Riverton was the division winner with 119.33 team points, Galena placed second with 86.83 points and St. Mary's-Colgan was third with 76.

While Ohmart's time was good enough for a new CJHS record, she placed second in the event at the league contest and tied for

third in the 400 Meter Dash. Lydia Wilkins placed second for the seventh grade

Lady Titans in the Discus

and Piper Hill placed third Tatum Clark, Columbus, in the 100 Meter Hurdles. The 4x400 Meter Relay team of Lauryn Flood, Hill, Ohmart, and Raelee Engroff also placed third.

Columbus totaled 43 points to place fifth in the seventh grade girls division. Girard was the winner with 110.5 team points, St. Mary's-Colgan placed second with 85 points, Frontenac was third with 77.5 points, and Baxter Springs was fourth with 67.


